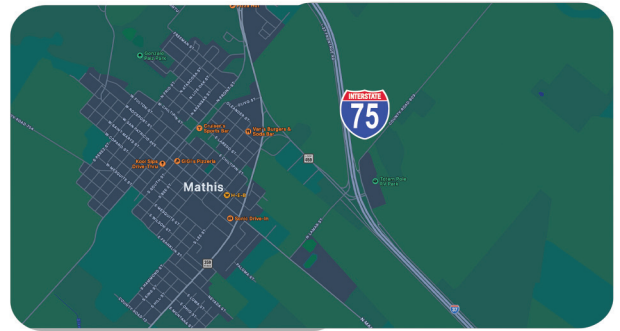


Heritage & LAKESIDE LEISURE

With a rich history dating back to its founding in 1887, Mathis owes its name and location to Thomas H. Mathis, who generously donated 300 acres for a townsite and school, sparking the city's growth. The city's early prosperity was further boosted as residents from Lagarto moved closer to the newly laid tracks of the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railroad. The establishment of a post office in 1890 and the opening of its first school in 1893 marked the beginning of a flourishing community.

Officially incorporated in 1939, Mathis has grown into a city of culinary delights, renowned for its mouthwatering BBQ, authentic Mexican cuisine, and a variety of other flavors that cater to every palate. With a population of 5,034 as of the 2000 census, Mathis embodies the spirit of small-town Texas life, enriched by a legacy of community, education, and delicious local dining.
